Notes

- 1 From 6 April 2008 the UK Government will add an extra 3p for every £1 donated under Gift Aid, which means that a charity will receive a total of 28p for every £1 donated.
- 2 You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the charity.
- 3 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax, you should cancel the declaration by notifying the charity.
- 4 If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
- 5 If you are unsure about whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity, or refer to the HM Revenue & Customs website (www.hmrc.gov.uk/incometax/relief-gift-aid.htm).
